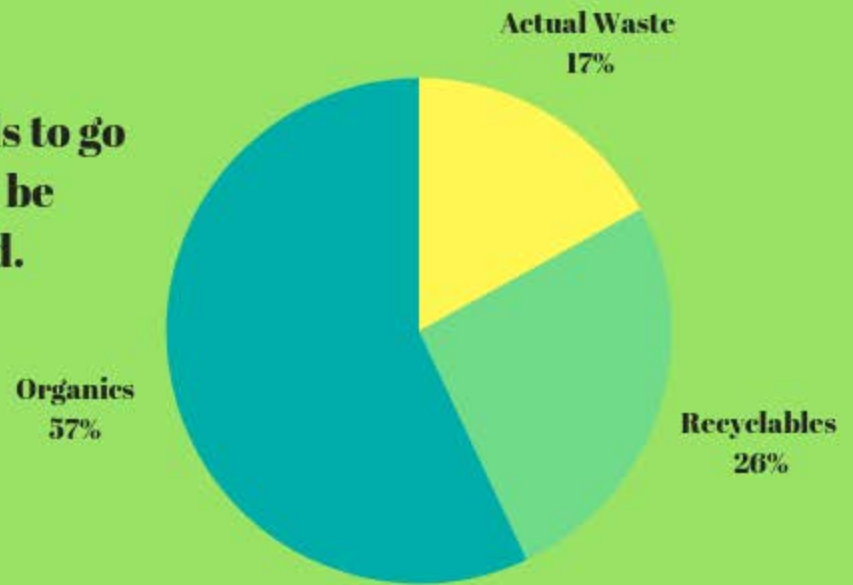

Making a Difference



More than half of what we throw away in the garbage is compostable.



Making simple changes to your routine like doing weekly meal planning and making use of food that's already on hand can have a big impact on your wallet and reduce unnecessary food waste.



Taking 30 seconds out of each day could save the planet years of contamination.



Organics recycling can keep up to 85 million kilograms of food waste out of landfills each year.

Collecting Food Waste

Using a green bin is easy and will quickly become a part of your everyday routine within your office.

Here's how you get started

At each deskside is a small green bin. This is to be used for small organic waste.

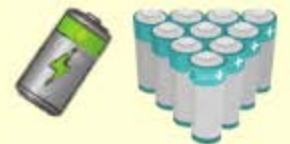
